David H. Perecman named to *Super Lawyers* three consecutive years



MINNEAPOLIS — Nov. 10, 2009: Minneapolis-based Law & Politics, publishers of [Super Lawyers](#) magazines, announced that New York, N.Y., personal injury plaintiff attorney [David Perecman](#) has been named to the 2009 edition of *New York Metro Super Lawyers*. Each year, no more than 5 percent of the lawyers in the state receive this honor.

He has more than 30 years of experience in construction, premises, automobile accidents and medical malpractice.

After winning a \$600,000 verdict against the now-defunct Gimbels department store in 1983, Perecman founded his firm. Since then, he has taken dozens of personal injury cases to verdict settled many more midtrial with verdicts and settlements mounting up over the \$100 million dollar mark. One recent victory was a \$15 million verdict for a construction worker who fractured his arm. As a result of these high-stakes cases, Perecman is listed in the Multi-Million Dollar Advocates Forum, National Law Journal's Hall of Fame and Best Lawyers in America. His expertise has brought him to Court TV, where he has been a commentator.

Perecman serves on the executive committee and the board of directors of the New York State Trial Lawyers Association. He handles high profile cases such as his recent victory on behalf of the former fiancée of Vincent Pastore (Big Pussy of "The Sopranos"). He also actively lobbies for worker and consumer rights.
