Larry H. Krantz named to *Super Lawyers* two consecutive years

Krantz is a fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, a former director of the New York Council of Defense Lawyers, a member of the Joint Local Rules Committee for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York and a member of the Federal Bar Council Inn of Court.

He is admitted to practice in New York, the District of Connecticut, the U.S. Courts of Appeal for the 2nd and 8th Circuits and the U.S. Supreme Court.
