Wayne Fisher named to *Super Lawyers* seven consecutive years

Fisher is board certified in personal injury trial law by the Texas Board of Legal Specialization and the State Bar of Texas. He is a past president of the State bar of Texas, the International Academy of Trial Lawyers and the Texas and Houston Trial Lawyers Associations. He is also a fellow of the Inner Circle of Advocates, whose membership is limited by invitation to only 100 lawyers in America who obtained jury verdicts in excess of one million dollars for their clients.

Outside of his practice, he is currently the chairman of the Texas Cultural Trust, an organization that promotes the importance of the arts in Texas. Fisher is on the board of trustees of Scott & White Healthcare, a nationally-known teaching hospital. He is also a trustee for the Center for American and International Law. He has served as a board member of the Texas 4-H Foundation, the Houston Symphony Society and the U.S. Supreme Court Historical Society. Fisher has also served as trustee for South Texas College of Law and the Center for American and International Law.

Fisher has been named Lawyer of the Year by Baylor University School of Law and recognized by Baylor University as one of its Outstanding Alumni. He owns Alligator Creek Ranch near Gause, Texas, where he raises registered Beefmaster and commercial cattle.
