**Steven C. Salch named to *Super Lawyers* seven consecutive years**

In 1994, he co-authored the book "Tax Practice Before the IRS."

In 2008, Salch was named Outstanding Texas Tax Lawyer by the tax section of the State Bar of Texas. In addition to being a member of the State Bar of Texas, Salch is the Vice Chair of the American College of Tax Counsel and formerly served as Chair of the 26,000-member Section of Taxation of the American Bar Association. He is also one of less than 1,500 lawyers selected to Best Lawyers in America for the 25-year history of the rating service from 1983 through 2009.

Salch is fluent in English and Spanish, and frequently lectures at state and local Bar CLE events.
