

## **Tony Buzbee, third year named to *Super Lawyers***

Buzbee has been lead counsel in numerous death cases that have resulted from the negligence of others. He has represented hundreds of maritime workers in Jones Act and maritime suits on claims related to injuries suffered while working offshore and on dredges. Buzbee has also represented offshore workers who alleged that their wages had been suppressed by their employers and maritime workers who claimed their workplace was riddled with asbestos.

In the commercial realm, Buzbee has represented the Port of Galveston in a breach of contract and fraud case pertaining to the construction of an offshore vessel facility that was to be built in Galveston. He also represented more than 150 clients in claims related to the BP explosion in Texas City, Texas.

In one of Buzbee's landmark cases, he was retained by Spain's Basque government to bring claims against a U.S. classification society, related to the sinking of the Prestige oil tanker. In another, he was hired by Jimmy Buffett to bring trademark infringement claims against a vendor of Buffett-related merchandise.

Buzbee graduated from the University of Houston Law Center, summa cum laude, after a prestigious term of service in the Marines.
