Richard A. Gump, Jr. named to *Super Lawyers* seven consecutive years

He is active in the community, currently serving on the Executive Committee of the Board of Directors of the YMCA of Metropolitan Dallas where he also chairs the Strategic Issues Committee. Gump has also served as President of the Board of Directors of Catholic Charities, the Downtown YMCA, and the Dallas Texas Exes—a local chapter of the alumni association for The University of Texas.
