Eastern Airlines Inc.*, in which he recovered \$1 million from Atlanta for the City of College Park; and *World Famous Dudley's Food & Spirits Inc., et al v. City of College Park*, in which Fincher effectively removed strip clubs from College Park.

Fincher works extensively with developers, boards of commissioners, as well as the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Regional Transportation Authority. He has handled hundreds of millions of dollars in project financing for developers and development and redevelopment projects for many cities.

Fincher's professional memberships include the State Bar of Georgia's School and College Section; Aviation Section and Local Government Section; and the Georgia Municipal Association City Attorney Section. Fincher also serves on the Clayton State University Foundation Board.
