Additionally, Klopman counsels on matters related to ADEA, Title VII, FLSA, GINA, FMLA, the Colorado Anti-Discrimination Act (including lawful off-duty claims), the Colorado Wage Act, ARRA retaliation, whistleblower claims, unemployment insurance matters, medical marijuana, and drug and alcohol testing regulations, among others. She also trains managers and non-managers on sexual harassment prevention and other employment topics. Klopman teaches seminars to attorneys and non-attorneys, including a CLE on association claims under the ADA/Title VII and a GINA presentation for the hospitality industry.
